Name of Convention? Buffalo Nasfic 2024

What dates will your convention run? July 18-21, 2023

What is your proposed convention host city? Buffalo, New York

Is your convention site in a city center location or a suburb? If a suburb, what are the transport options into the city center? How far is the site from the city center?

The convention will be held in Buffalo, New York. It will be an eight-minute walk (0.4 miles) or three-minute bus ride from Buffalo City Hall at Niagara Square, which is the hub for many of the region's bus routes. The intercity Greyhound Bus Terminal is half a mile (ten-minute walk) south of the convention site. The Amtrak train station is a block from the bus terminal.

Buffalo Airport (BUF) is ten miles east of downtown. The #24 Genesee NFTA ("Metro") bus runs every 25-30 minutes, takes 40 minutes to get downtown, and stops four minutes walk from the hotel. The bus fare is \$2. There are also shared-shuttle options for \$21, and taxis available.

What are your main facilities? How far are your hotels from your main venue?

Most of our program spaces are in the Hyatt Regency Buffalo. We are also using the Buffalo Convention Center for exhibits (art show, dealers, etc.) and main stage events. These buildings are connected by a short indoor corridor

Buffalo Airport is served by most major US airlines, including United, Delta, American, Southwest, Frontier, JetBlue, and vacation charters.

Are direct flights from the cities above flown into your local airport?

Buffalo gets many flights a day from New York, Chicago, and Washington, as well as Atlanta, Dallas, Los Angeles, Denver, Dallas, Boston, Philadelphia, Minneapolis, several cities in Florida, other cities, and Cancun.

With a direct bus service from Toronto Airport to the Buffalo Greyhound Terminal, a few minutes walk from the hotel, Toronto is also a good airport for Canadian or international travelers to get to the convention site. Toronto is served by all Canadian and most global airlines from national capitals and other major cities.

How far is your convention site from the nearest airport/train station and what is the likely cost of getting to the hotels by both public transport, shared ride service (Lyft/Uber/etc.), and taxi from that airport/train station?

Downtown Buffalo is 9.9 miles from Buffalo Airport. The Hyatt Regency Buffalo is 0.5 miles from the Amtrak station. It's a 40-minute bus ride from the airport and a three-minute bus ride from the train station. Bus fare is \$2. Shared shuttle from the airport is \$21 one way, while a taxi is about \$35. A taxi from the train station to the hotel might be \$6-\$7 including tip.

What hotel(s) are being used for the convention?

The Buffalo Hyatt Regency Hotel

How many rooms, what type, accessibility issues, etc.?

The Hyatt Regency Buffalo has 396 non-smoking guest rooms, including 9 accessible rooms. Our room block is 950 room nights from Wednesday to Monday, with a peak of 240 on each of Friday and Saturday.

What are your hotel room rates?

Please describe the policies / laws regarding smoking in your hotel(s), convention center, and city.

The Convention Center and the Hyatt are smoke-free facilities. New York State's Clean Indoor Air Act prohibits the smoking of tobacco products and the use of vapor products in nearly all indoor and certain outdoor public areas and workplaces. It was amended in 2021 to prohibit cannabis smoking and vaping in all locations in which smoking and vaping tobacco products are currently prohibited.

What type of weather can we expect during your convention? What is the average temperature during that time of year?

The breeze from Lake Erie that brings notoriously bad winter weather often brings a gentle, cooling breeze in the summer. Average highs are in the upper seventies, with nighttime lows in the mid sixties, but the United States can be a warm country in the summer so this is variable.

What are some of the main tourist attractions of your city?

Among other attractions, Buffalo is a short drive from Niagara Falls, one of the Seven Wonders of the World.

The local aspect of fandom in Buffalo has to do with either Comic-cons, anime cons, or local gaming conventions.

Buffalo happens to have more than one country within walking distance as well as racially and culturally distinct neighborhoods with different traditions and perspectives. Buffalo fandom is in a transitional situation, where some have decades of experience in traditional fandom where others know only visual media and comic books. We look forward to reinventing our dynamic to bring groups together to learn from each other.

We have agreed on a code of conduct and it should be available on our website.
